Framing

Artwork must be "gallery ready": framed (indicate size above), wired with screw eyes, ready to hang. (No sawtooth hangers.) Matted art without a frame is unacceptable. Sculptures are not to exceed 125 lbs.

Media

Watercolor, acrylic, oils, sculpture, pottery, weaving, metal, etc.

Price

You set your own price listed on the back of the painting. The price includes the 15% commission paid to the What's Art Convention

Payment for sold art will for cash items will be made at 5PM on October 3rd. Checks will need 5 working days to clear, and then will be mailed (less 15% commission) to your address.

LABEL AFFIXED TO WORK OF ART

Please attach Artist name, Title of work, Media, Size of work, Sales Price to include 15% commission affixed to the work.

What's Art? Reserves the right to reject any piece of art which is deemed inappropriate to hang for public display

DISPLAY AREA

All art will be displayed indoors, in the Alma d'arte Charter High School (in auditorium and in main hall, on display racks. Security will be provided. During daylight hours a sales person will be present to show your art.

Drop-off between 9:00AM – 5PM on October 1st at Alma d'Arte Charter High School.

Pick-up of Art after 4:00PM and before 5:00PM on October 3 A photo ID is required to pick up art pieces.

(Art not claimed by 5PM Oct 3rd will be stored in Alma d'arte, and artist is responsible for making arrangements on following Monday to Friday for pickup.

MARKETING/SALES – While not required, it would help to have an artist bio, a statement of the style/tradition/innovation of the pieces, and images of the art items, for web display, and sales training of our staff. The intent is to locate buyers before the sale and alert them to the availability of various pieces.
